





# LIFE SCIENCES IN WEXFORD

The life sciences sector forms a rich part of the tapestry of industry in Wexford. The county has a growing base of companies involved in manufacturing and other activities related to the life sciences sector. Companies like Waters Technologies, Integer and Medentech have all located in Wexford and manufacture products from their Wexford facilities for the global market. These companies have established themselves as leaders within their own fields, exceeding expectations and growing significantly.

Eighteen of the world's top 20 pharmaceutical companies have substantial operations in Ireland. Wexford has proven itself as a great business base for Life Science companies.

- The life sciences sector in Ireland employs over 50,000 people directly and exports over €45 billion annually.
- The Irish Government has committed €8.2 billion in science and technology centres of excellence
- Cardiovascular: 80% of global stent production is carried out in Ireland.

BD Enniscorthy is an innovative developer and manufacturer of minimally invasive medical devices such as catheters and stents that are used in interventional procedures such as angioplasty. Angioplasty catheters are used to clear blocked arteries, and stents are permanently implanted devices used to prevent prolapse of the artery following the angioplasty procedure. From their state of the art facility situated in Enniscorthy, BD products are sold worldwide. BD has operated in Enniscorthy since 1996.

#### Medentech, part of the Kersia group

Medentech develops, manufactures and markets cost effective disinfection solutions. Based in Wexford and a global leader in water disinfection and hospital infection control since 1984, Medentech distributes to over 120 countries worldwide. In 2018, Aquatabs, Medentech's globally respected disinfection tablets, disinfected 30 billion litres of water worldwide, whilst the surface disinfection tablet, KK2 was approved by the EPA as the first product effective against dry surface biofilm.

Medentech's innovative water disinfection system, the Aquatabs Flo, is currently providing safe drinking water to over 6.5 million schoolchildren across Africa. The target is to reach 15 million schoolchildren by the end of 2019.

#### Waters

Waters Corporation (NYSE: WAT), the world's leading specialty measurement company, has pioneered chromatography, mass spectrometry and thermal analysis innovations serving the life, materials and food sciences for over 60 years. With approximately 7,000 employees worldwide, Waters operates directly in 31 countries, including 15 manufacturing facilities, and with products available in more than 100 countries. Waters Technologies Ireland Ltd, a state-of-the-art manufacturing and assembly facilities in Wexford, Ireland was established in 1997 and currently employs over 340 people. It is the manufacturing centre of excellence for Waters Mass Spectrometry Instruments, Chemistry consumables and Informatics products worldwide. The site is also responsible for the design and development of chemistry reagent kits.

#### Integer

Integer, formally Lake Region Medical is the largest Guidewire Manufacturer in the World and offers an extensive line of OEM guidewires designed to meet the unique requirements of a large range of clinical applications.

Additionally, as a global leader in guidewire design and development, Integer manufactures custom guidewire solutions for leading medical device companies. Utilizing proprietary platform technologies and advanced wire processing technologies, Integer manufactures high-precision guidewires that meet the required fitness of use, criticality, and safety parameters. The company has been operating from a facility in New Ross, Co. Wexford since 1994 and currently employs over 950 associates. The site at New Ross was awarded the prestigious Shingo Bronze Medallion in 2012 & 2015, the first European Medical Device Company to receive this award for world-class operational excellence.

## PROPERTY SOLUTIONS ACROSS COUNTY WEXFORD

Wexford County has a more competitive cost base than Dublin - the cost of living, wages and business costs all lower. Wexford offers a range of property solutions to support new or expanding businesses:

Work is underway at the new Enniscorthy Technology Park in Killagoley, Enniscorthy, on approximately 14.45 hectares. The development will facilitate Small and Medium Enterprises from the science and technology sectors.

Wexford County Council currently have 2 industrial sites available for design and build options located in Butlersland, New Ross.

In Gorey, the M11 Business Campus offers modern and contemporary multi-functional commercial office space with integrated eFibre for high speed, secure broadband, and interna CAT 6a cabling. With access to the M11, ample parking and the facilities within nearby Gorey town, this is an excellent site from which to do business. The Hatch Lab is a co-working space withi the M11 Campus."

Wexford County Council has a dedicated team dealing with planning applications with job creation potential, ensuring a seamless service as part of our business support package. County Wexford has greenfield sites, including serviced sites, available in business and technology parks and zoned industri land banks. There are available lands at IDA Wexford Business Technology Park and IDA Enniscorthy Industrial Estate.

There is a good supply of vacant industrial units and ready-togo office accommodation for both sale and lease within zoned lands. Wexford County Council operates a grant scheme towards refurbishment and fit-out costs under a Vacant Property Incentive Scheme and a capped reduction on rates through an early payment incentive.
